

INFANT SCHOOL: ANTI COVID PROTOCOL FOR THE FAMILIES

1. **The access to the school secretariat** will be guaranteed every day **previous appointment**.
2. No entry to school for parents (except in particular cases). In case parents forget to take to school material or personal effects, they are not to go to school. Children can do without.
3. The **educational material**, including toys, of each class cannot be shared with other classes. Toys will be sanitized daily.
4. In each school entry and exit routes are available, which must be strictly observed. Families will be informed of all available entrances, including emergency doors and stairways.
5. In each infant school different time slots are available for entry and exit:
Entry:
 - 8.00-8.30 (both parents working)
 - 8.30- 9.00 (all the other parents)Exit (short time agreed with teachers for new entries):
 - Exit before lunch from 11.20 to 11.30
 - Exit after lunch from 12.30 to 13.00
 - Last exit from 15.40 to 16.00 (if the time 8.00/16.00) will be activated.

Parents must strictly respect the times indicated

6. Only one parent or one person delegated is allowed to access to the school for the drop off and the pick up of three-year old children. **The parent wearing the mask can only have access in the hall and in the " locker area"**. It's forbidden to parents and/ or brothers or sisters to enter the classroom, the dormitories and the toilets for any reasons.
7. At the entrance and exit the **interpersonal distance of at least one metre** must be respected and you will have to wait for your turn for the access to the locker. **Staying is allowed for the time strictly necessary**.
8. **Parents must not send their children to school** if they have a temperature equal or higher than 37.5 degrees, cough and/or cold or if they have come into contact with people tested positive for the COVID virus in the previous 14 days or with people staying in precautionary isolation.
9. If the child feels sick at school and shows the typical virus symptoms, the safety protocol prepared by the Technical Scientific Committee will be applied. Parents must be available **in case a child feels ill at school** and must pick him/her up as soon as possible.

10. **After absence due to illness of more than three days** a medical certificate is required (from the pediatrician/ general practitioner)
11. **No toys or personal belongings can be taken to school.** Please reduce as much as possible personal effects in the lockers.
12. There will be **specific time slots to facilitate the integration of three- year old children, which parents must strictly respect.**
